

# Supplemental Mini-CAREWare Guide

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Ending HIV Epidemic and Status Neutral -  
HIV Negative Additional Data Elements

### Overview

To help deliver better prevention and care and ultimately reduce new HIV infections in the District and the United States, DC HAHSTA adopted a status-neutral service provision approach. The approach prioritizes the engagement of both people living with HIV and person who are behaviorally vulnerable to HIV. A status-neutral approach to HIV aims to deliver high-quality, culturally affirming health care in every interaction, supporting optimal health for people living without HIV (Part B RFA). As such, the data collected should reflect and support the aim of the status neutral approach. All Part B and EHE funded organization are required to provide additional demographic, services and clinical data in order to comply with their funding and contract requirement. This supplemental mini-CAREWare guide will help demonstrate how to collect all required data elements using existing and new CAREWare fields.

It is strongly recommended that for HIV-negative (except affected) clients RW eligibility are not completed as it has RSR reporting related implications.

### Funding Source and Contract

Ryan White Part B, Ryan White Program Income (Rebates), and Federal Payments will be braided to support a status-neutral effort. The Project anticipates a four-year period and with the start date of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2026. The Grant Period will be the same as Part B grant year (April to March). The funding source name for the status neutral effort is named “Braided Funding-Status Neutral” in CAREWare for reporting. The contract name will be “Status Neutral\_ProviderName\_DC\_GY32.”

### Part I - Status Neutral Service Tracking

Service Categories are the same as traditional Ryan White Services. Additionally, subservices under each service category will remain the same except subservice only applicable to HIV positive individuals are being removed.

Please enter services record as you would for any other Ryan White services. Make sure to select the contract first prior to making any subservice selection. Please refer the [DC EMA CAREWare quick user guide](#) for steps on how to enter service data to CW.

### Part II-Collect PrEP Familiarity, PrEP screening, and HIV testing data using CAREWare

The code next to the data elements (i.e. H800) is the Centers for Disease Control’s Evalweb data element specifications and are pertinent to the providers who are funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) through the Ending the Epidemic (EHE) initiatives. The following elements were adapted from Evalweb to track PrEP and HIV testing data in CAREWare for the Part B status neutral program.

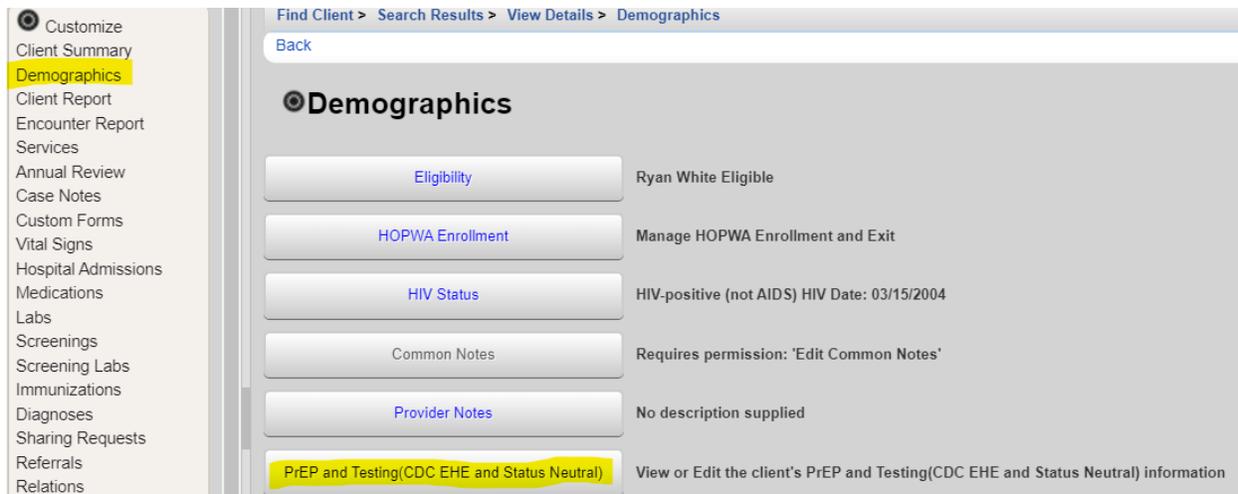

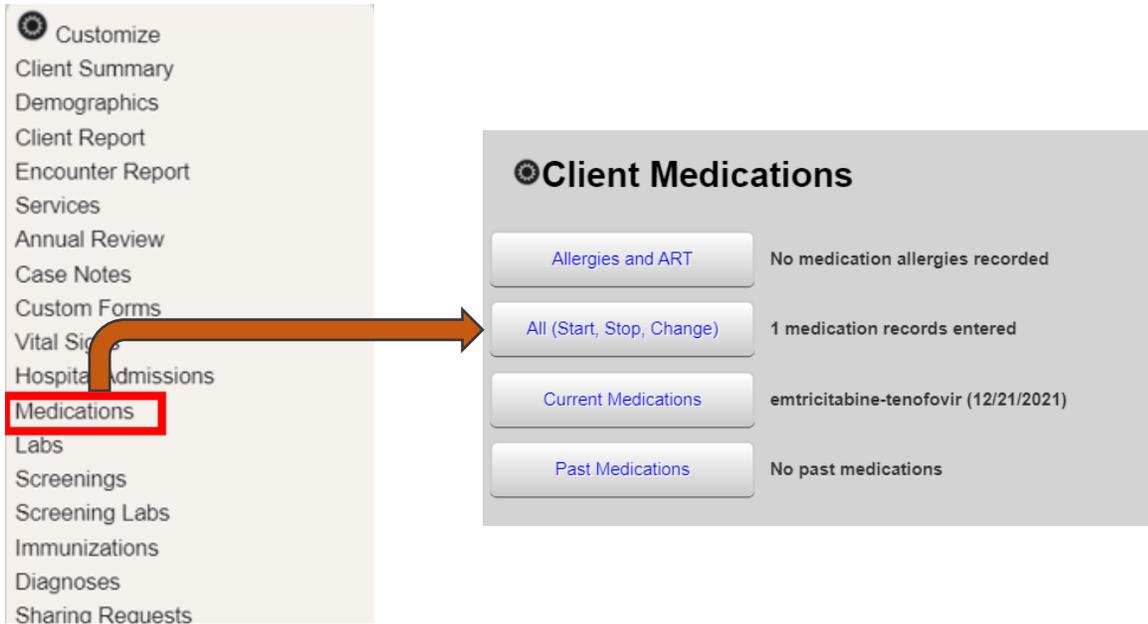

### Part IV- Documenting PrEP and PEP in CAREWare

1. Find the Client that you will enter a PrEP records for
2. On the left-hand side locate the **Medication** module and click on it. New medication link menu and their summary will appear on the right as shown below.



3. Click on All (Strat, Stop, Change) tab. Complete all sections as indicated below. The default indication option is ART. Change it to “Other”. In the comment field, type “PrEP” or “PEP” depending on the type of medication. Then Click save.
